If you are injured as a STEELERS endorsed event please ensure you send the club the first aid form from the first aid officer and we will send you the insurance papers.

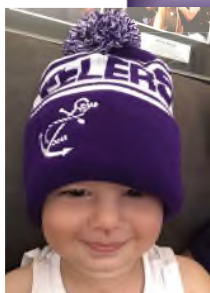

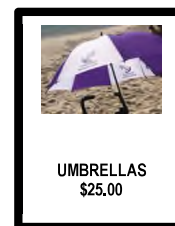

We also have 4 x 3 seater bench seats for sale at \$80 each (RRP \$120). Please message Net on 0418 594 274 to

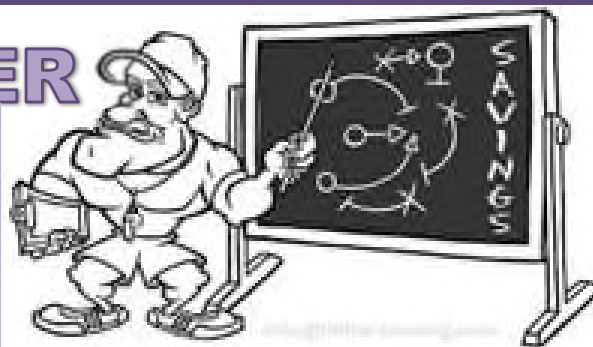






# COACHES CORNER

# UMPIRE'S UNVEILED



## Rule in Focus

A massive thank you to everyone who has stepped as either a team umpire or fill in umpire! An umpire is the one person who gets receives the most nonsense every game, so here is your reminder to be kind to your umpire. If you have any issues with your umpire, you can check your coaches and managers packs for a handy cheat sheet. Briefly, the steps are as follows:

1. Ask both umpires a question about the rules. Remember only the captain and (optionally) the player with the question can approach the umpires.
2. If you have Squad or Green-shirt umpires, get your assistant coach or manager to ask their umpire coach. They are easily identifiable by red vests.
3. Send your coach or manager to the match office with your team card if the issue continues or gets worse.
4. After the game, send an email to STEELERS outlining whether the umpire was club or squad, your team number and exactly what the issue was.

Under no circumstances should you yell at or belittle the umpire. This will result in an immediate fine. So take a deep breath and remember it is just a game and umpires are human, someone son or daughter

Please note that any time you need to approach an umpire coach or the match office it should be an official of the team who must know exactly what the issue is. In the case of approaching the match office they will be required to fill in a form detailing their request.

For coaches whose teams have Squad and Green-shirt Umpires, you are invited to attend a meeting on Sunday May 12th, 5-6:30PM. At this meeting WDNA umpire coordinator Rachel Williams will go through everything you need to know about having a Squad or Green-shirt umpire, and how you can assist with furthering their umpiring skills and learning.

### Rule in Focus: ADVANTAGE

The umpire should refrain from blowing the whistle for an infringement when by so doing the non-infringing team would be disadvantaged.

- (i) The umpire indicates an advantage is being applied by:
  - (a) Calling 'advantage' and stating the infringement
  - (b) Using the hand signal for advantage.
- (ii) If the whistle is blown for an infringement the sanction must be awarded, except that if a goal is scored that is to the advantage of the non-infringing team, the umpire will award the goal.

Keep an ear out for the whistle. If it isn't blown, it was likely an advantage call and you can keep playing. Always listen to your umpire.
